


DARK AGES: BRITANNIA & FRANCE by WBS Games



DAF (Dark Ages: Britannia & France) is a light board wargame allowing you to command a medieval army in some of the most important battles of the Middle Age.

Play the role of Duke William in Hastings or Wallace in Stirling bridge, try and change history at Agincourt or Courtrai.

“Dark Ages: Britannia & France” is the second edition of a previous game “Dark Ages: Britannia”, that came out a couple of years ago. The old game has been improved, both in terms of graphics/materials and mechanics (check out the main differences between the old and the new edition on the Boardgamegeek page of the game).

But **DAF** is not just a game, it is a long-term project, in which several expansions planned for the future will enable you to play medieval battles not only in the fields of Western Europe, but also in the fields of Central, Eastern Europe and the Middle-East. You’ll be able to make the best of some of the materials (cubes and unit counters) you already have, so that the more expansions you get, the less they will cost you.
