Turn Summary

Comrade Stalin has abruptly recovered from his temporary incapacitation and directed a "Great Patriotic War" to repel the Axis invaders. All segments of Soviet society will tenaciously support the war effort, whether it be fighting on the front, producing war munitions, building fortifications, or conducting partisan activities.

Across the front, Soviet forces have retrograded to more defensible terrain and are determined to protect key centers of gravity while rapid mobilization occurs. Abandonment of the 8th and 27th Infantry Armies was an unfortunate trade off.

Given the speed and surprise of the Axis advance, the *NKVD* is uncertain where the next thrusts will occur. Leningrad, Smolensk, Kiev, and Odessa are all potential targets. How will the Axis invasion proceed?
