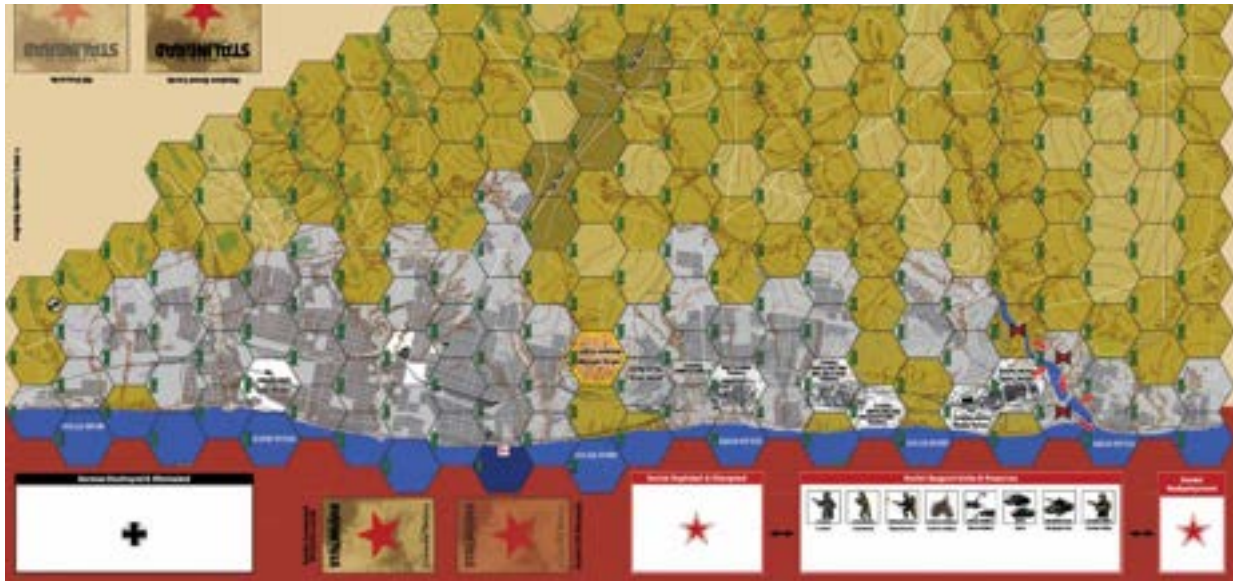

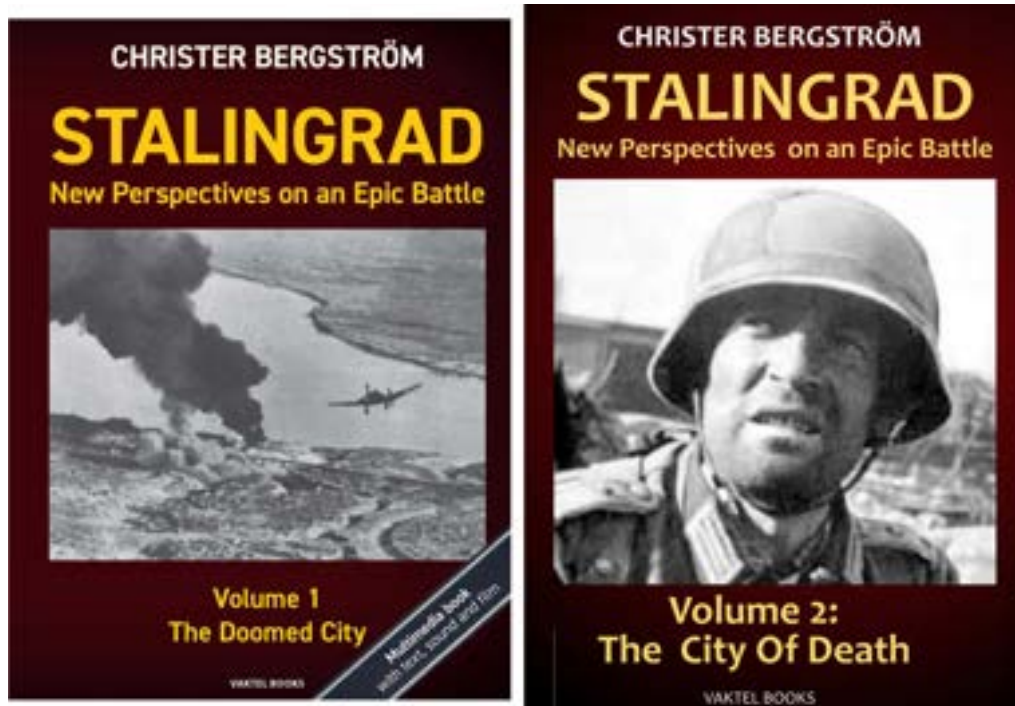

The Campaign in Egypt 1798-1801 UPDATE

The French version of this new book was published in December. The **English-language edition** should be translated and printed in **May**.

This extraordinary volume contains 196 large format 9.5 inches x 12.5 inches pages with some never before published illustrations by E. Lelievre, P. Courcelle, L. Rousselot, and H. Boisselier.
